



Payment Options and Explanations:

OPTION A: Reserve

Provide a credit card that will be used by our billing company to charge your balance once your insurance company has done their part and has determined what portion is your responsibility. This is called our "Reserve" option. We (Velocity Care) do not store your credit card information - - it is encrypted into our computer system for future use. No funds are withheld from the credit card you provide, nor are any charges added to your credit card today. By choosing this option, you are merely giving us *permission* to charge your card *up to* \$250 within the next 90 days after your insurance company has done their part.

OPTION B: Allowables

At check-out, we will calculate what amounts your insurance "allows" for the services we have provided. These "allowables" are based on the contracted rate that we have agreed to with your insurer *and* the insurance plan that you signed up for. Once the "allowable" for today's visit is determined, you will be responsible for at least 50% of that amount today and we will bill you any balance that remains once your insurance company has done their part. This is called our "Allowables" option. By choosing this option, you are agreeing to pay 50% of your insurance allowable amount today and to be billed for the balance. (All outstanding account balances must be paid prior to future services being rendered.)

Effective January 1, 2013, these will be the only acceptable payment options.
